

Springtime Tatted Hand Towel

Materials needed:

One Tatting Shuttle

One ball crochet cotton thread size 10. Color: variegated

Four balls crochet cotton thread size 10. Color: Four different solid colors, to coordinate with the Variegated thread.

Four flower appliqués of your choice, purchased at a craft or sewing center.

One Hand Towel

General Abbreviations

R = Ring

Ch = Chain

PR = Previous Ring

Dash = picot

+ = Join

General Instructions

Use solid color thread for rings and variegated thread for all chains.

Reverse work between all rings and chains. Do not reverse work between rings in corner clover.

Blocks are labeled A, B, C, & D. First block A, at the top. Blocks B, C, D clockwise around.

Pattern consists of Rings, Chains and Corner Clovers. The long outside edge has 11 rings between the Corner Clovers. The shorter inside row has 7 rings between the Corner Clovers.

Hand stitch finished tatted blocks onto a Hand Towel. Hand stitch purchased flower appliqués in the centers of each tatted block

Springtime Tatted Hand Towel

Block A

R 4 – 4 – 4 – 4

Ch 3 – 3

*R 4 + (third picot of PR) 4 – 4 – 4

Ch 3 – 3 *

Repeat * to * nine times

Corner: R 4 + (third picot of PR) 4 – 4 – 4 DO NOT REVERSE WORK

R 4 + (third picot of PR) 2 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 4 DO NOT REVERSE WORK

R 4 + (last picot of PR) 4 – 4 – 4

CH 3 – 3

*R 4 + (third picot of PR) 4 – 4 – 4

Ch 3 – 3*

Repeat * to * six times

Corner: R 4 + (third picot of PR) 4 – 4 – 4 DO NOT REVERSE WORK

R 4 + (third picot of PR) 2 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 4 DO NOT REVERSE WORK

R 4 + (last picot of PR) 4 – 4 – 4

CH 3 – 3

*R 4 + (third picot of PR) 4 – 4 – 4

Ch 3 – 3*

Repeat * to * six times

Corner: Corner: R 4 + (third picot of PR) 4 – 4 – 4 DO NOT REVERSE WORK

R 4 + (third picot of PR) 2 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 4 DO NOT REVERSE WORK

R 4 + (last picot of PR) 4 – 4 + (to beginning ring) 4

CH 3 – 3

Cut & Tie to base of beginning ring.

Block B & C

Change colors of ring threads for each block. Follow the above pattern, joining rings to the opposite rings of the previous block of the third short side.

Block D

Follow the above pattern, joining rings to the opposite rings of the short side of Blocks C and A.
